## **2014 Seneca Falls Major Baseball Local Rules**

1. The spirit of the game should be upheld and good sportsmanship should be displayed at all times. If a team is winning by 15 runs, they can't send runners home on a passed ball from third base.
2. A rotation of substitutes should be employed. A player should not play every single inning of every single game. Each player should sit out a few innings throughout the course of a season.
3. The manager is responsible for the sportsmanship of the parents in the stands. Good sportsmanship should be displayed at all times on and off the field.
4. If a player arrives after the game has started they will be inserted into the bottom of the lineup without penalty.
5. No inning should start after 8:00 on a school night, or after 10:00 on a non-school night. Once an inning is started, it should be completed.
6. A continuous batting order will be utilized.
7. If a game is tied after 6 full innings of play, it is recorded as a tie. All ties will be worth 1 point in the standings and all wins will be worth 2 points in the standings.
8. Four innings must be completed in order for the game to be considered official. If the home team is up by 10 runs and the visiting team has batted in the top of the 4th inning, the game should be called as a mercy win. If both coaches agree and time permits they may finish the game without keeping score.
9. If a pitcher hits 3 batters in a game, that pitcher will be removed.
10. Both managers are responsible for the orderly maintenance of the dugout.
11. The home team manager is responsible for the following:
  - a. setting up the pitching machine
  - b. lining the field
  - c. raking the field
  - d. providing 2 new balls
  - e. removal and storage of the tarps before the game
  - f. installation of the tarps if you are the last game of the night
  - g. ensuring that everything is turned off and cleaned up in the press box
  - h. locking of the press box, if you are the last game of the night
